NEW ONLINE OEA-R VOTING PROCEDURE!

- OEA-Retired Delegate Election
- OEA-R Advisory Council Vice-Chair Election

OEA-R members should look an email and/or a postcard "Vote now in the OEA Retired 2016 Elections" from "OEA Retired Elections Admin help@election-america.com". OEA-R Elections will now be done online. Everyone will get a postcard with an explanation and instructions for requesting a paper ballot in the mail. The email and the postcard provide a link, taking you to the voting page, and an "Election Code" and a "Voting PIN". Please vote online no later than Friday, October 31, 2016.

OEA-R members will fill the vacancy for **OEA-R Advisory Council Vice-Chair**. **Gary Hollow, Donna Smoot-Walters,** and **Beverly Woolridge** from NEOEA are running in a field of five candidates. Please consider supporting one of our NEOEA candidates.

OEA-R members will also elect 28 **Delegates** to the **OEA Representative Assembly** from a field of 36 candidates. The 18 OEA -Retired Advisory Council members are automatic delegates by virtue of office, for a delegation of 46 delegates and 6 alternates by order of votes.
