2018 OEA-FCPE Candidate Screening Committees

OEA-FCPE Candidate Screening Committees are forming this fall. In the spring, the committees will screen and endorse candidates for the Ohio General Assembly based on OEA legislative and educational priorities. One retiree will be appointed to each House District Screening Committee along with representatives from each local association whose school district is wholly or partially within that House District. The committees will chose a Chair and Vice Chair as well as a Delegate and Alternate to the OEA-FCPE Convention. The three House District committees within a Senate District combine to form the Senate District Committee and select a Chair, Vice Chair, Delegate, and Alternate.

Interested in serving? Please contact NEOEA President Jeff Wensing or NEOEA Executive Director Mary Alice Conkey by October 6, 2017. Most people are appointed to serve on the House District Committee in which they live, but on occasion you may be asked to serve on an adjoining House District Committee. Members not recommended for appointment will be considered for Alternate positions.

This year, rather than organizational meetings for the House District Screening Committees being held separately by LRC liaisons, the meetings will be grouped by the three NEOEA District Screening Councils on three dates: October 16, November 20, and December 11. Each DSC group will be assigned to one of the dates and a location east, west, or central as arrangements are finalized.

Members who were recommended in the last cycle were contacted about their intention to continue. If you did not reply to that email, be sure to make your intentions known.
