OEA presented an educational Webinar regarding the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and the Government Pension Offset (GPO), two provisions in the Social Security

Act that were created with the intent of equally treating workers who pay Social Security taxes throughout their careers and those who do not pay Social Security taxes on all of their earnings. The provisions have caused nearly 2 million American workers to be denied benefits because they chose to enter public service.
